- 1. If cases were not ready at time of filing at 12:00 on Thursday 23 October 2025 (i.e. all relevant affidavits filed, the application indexed and paginated and a certificate of urgency and practice note filed), they will not be heard, unless there is good cause or exceptional circumstances.
- 2. No piece-meal filing of affidavits will be allowed.
- 3. The Case Lines bundle will be frozen by 12:00 on Monday 27 October 2025 and no further documents may be filed without the relevant Judge's specific written permission.
- 4. <u>All cases MUST be uploaded on Case Lines</u>. If any problems are experienced the particular Judge's registrar may be contacted TIMEOUSLY. In the absence thereof, where links have not been populated timeously (see par 1 supra), the matter will be struck from the roll.
- 5. It is the duty of the applicant's attorney to ensure that there are no duplicate cases created on Case Lines and to ensure that the particular Judge has received the correct link. In the event that this does not occur, and links remain unpopulated or the Judge has received the incorrect link, the matter will not be heard and will be removed or struck from the roll
- 6. Where no declaration of compliance and certificate of urgency has been filed and/or no practice note has been filed, the matter will be struck from the roll.
- 7. All draft orders are to be uploaded on Case Lines in "WORD- AND PDF format and the Draft orders must include A DISCLAIMER CLAUSE on or before Monday 27 October 2025 by 12H00, furthermore Parties are required to bring a hard copy of the draft order to court. Please ensure that the Judge's surname, date, case particulars and case number are correctly reflected on the draft order.
- 8. In all opposed matters, Heads of Argument are to be filed by both parties <u>before</u> <u>12H00 on Monday 27 October 2025</u>. Strict regard will be in terms of the rules of urgency.
- 9. All hearings will be in an open court and the court number will be on the daily roll.

- 10. An allocation does **NOT** mean that the matter is considered sufficiently urgent to hear on the merits. Submissions will need to be made regarding the grounds of urgency.
- 11. If there is non-compliance with the practice directive, the matter will be struck from the roll, unless good cause is shown for non-compliance.
