DIRECTIVES AND ALLOCATIONS

(Friday, 29 May 2026, 10h30)

1. The matters enrolled in urgent court for Week 8 of Term 2 and allocated to Moultrie J are listed below.
2. Applicants in all listed matters are directed to ensure that a duly paginated bundle is available on CaseLines by no later than 16h00 on Friday, 29 May 2026 containing all documents filed of record in the matter as at that time, and that the allocated Judge's secretary is "invited" to the case.
3. Any document filed by any party after 16h00 on 29 May 2026 must be both (i) uploaded onto CaseLines; and (ii) emailed to the Moultrie J's secretary on the email address above. In addition, all such documents must (save in exceptional cases where this is impossible) be duly filed on CourtOnline before being uploaded onto CaseLines and emailed, and the document uploaded and emailed must be the version of the document that was filed on CourtOnline (i.e. containing the CourtOnline coversheet showing time of filing and watermarks).
4. Counsel or attorneys appearing for each party should upload and email a short practice note (limited to 3 pages) by no later than **12h00 on Monday, 01 June 2026** setting out (i) brief submissions; (ii) authorities relied on; (iii) estimated duration of argument; and (iv) limitations of counsel regarding the date, time and manner of the hearing in the period between 2 and 5 June 2026. Preferably, this should be a joint practice note, in which case the page limit may be exceeded. Moultrie J will consider, but not be bound by, the stated limitations regarding dates, time and manner of hearing.

5. Representatives must ensure that the uploading of any document to the CaseLines file after 16h00 on 29 May 2026 does not affect the pagination of any other document in the bundle as at that time.
6. A further roll will be published on the afternoon of 1 June 2026 setting out any further directives and indicating the date, time and manner for the hearing of the matters listed below. Further or amended directives may also be published via “widely shared notes” posted on the CaseLines file. Parties are required to look out for these communications and respond thereto as requested.
7. Save as set out above, paragraphs 24.10 (dealing with return dates for rules *nisi*), 12.25 and 28 of Practice Directive 1 of 2024 (revised 12 June 2024), as well as the Practice Manual will be applied.
8. Any party unable to comply with any of the directions set out above, or becoming aware of any fact that may affect the smooth operation of the court must contact Moultrie J’s secretary, copying the legal representatives of the other parties (if any), as soon as they become aware of such inability or fact.
