DIRECTIVE: DEFAULT JUDGEMENT COURT – 13 JULY 2026 TO 17 JULY 2026

BEFORE THE HONOURABLE MADAM JUSTICE BABOOLAL-FRANK AJ

1. The Court will sit at **10:00**.
2. Matters will be conducted in Open Court.
3. Removals and postponements will be called first.
4. Introductions will be done in Court.
5. Draft orders: parties must have a hard copy to-hand up in Court, with a copy uploaded to Caselines.
6. The draft order must comply with the practice directive, i.e. the Judge's name, date, court room, parties representatives including Counsel etc. Including the below disclaimer:

"This Order is made an Order of Court by the Judge whose name is reflected herein, duly stamped by the Registrar of the Court and is submitted electronically to the Parties/their legal representatives by email. This Order is further uploaded to the electronic file of this matter on Case Lines by the Judge or his/her Secretary. The date of this Order is deemed to be [date/month/year]."

7. Details of the Road Accident Fund must also be included in the draft order, i.e. claims handler and claim/link number, if available.
8. All settlements, postponements and or removals must be brought under the attention of the acting Judge's registrar.
9. Parties are to comply with practice directives, including in relation to practice notes and the filing of documents on Caselines.

11. An Updated Practice Note, Heads of Argument and the proposed draft order must be filed by 12h00, a day before the hearing. Failure to do the same, may cause the matter to be removed from the roll.
