DIRECTIVE

1. All matters will be heard in open court commencing at 10h00. The court room will be reflected on the day roll.
2. Legal Practitioners need not introduce themselves to the Judge in chambers. Introductions will be done when matters are called.
3. Matters will be called based on seniority. Removals and postponements will be called first, thereafter matters will be heard.
4. The Judge should be informed of any removals or postponements as soon as possible, through email and a widely shared note on Caselines.
5. Strict compliance with paragraph 7 of Practice Directive 1 of 2024 is required in terms of uploading documents to Caselines. Matters that do not comply may be removed or struck off from the roll.

6. Parties must upload their practice notes (for SIC matters) or concise heads of argument (for default judgment hearings) by no later than 12H00 one day before the hearing date.
7. Parties must bring one hard copy of the Draft Order sought. Draft Orders must be uploaded on Caselines in MSWord and PDF format by no later than 12h00 one day before the hearing date.
8. The Judge will publish comments on Caselines, and practitioners are required to consider such comments before calling any matter.
