**COMBINED FAMILY COURT MATTERS BEFORE THE HONOURABLE ACTING JUDGE
F.BEZUIDENHOUT FOR THE WEEK OF 13 TO 17 JULY 2026**

DIRECTIVES:

1. The Judge invites all practitioners to indicate, should they so wish, by which pronouns they wish to be addressed.
2. Introductions will take place in court.
3. Matters that become settled, removed or postponed by agreement must be communicated without delay by email to the Judge's secretary Ms. Leletu Siqola LSiqola@judiciary.org.za .

4. If a draft order is to be made an order of court, one hard copy must be brought to court for handing up. Draft orders and settlement agreements, where applicable, must correctly reflect the Judge's correct particulars, **F.BEZUIDENHOUT AJ**, case number and date of hearing, the court and the correct names and contact details of both Counsel and their instructing attorney.
5. Court orders will be stamped, signed and uploaded within 7 court days.
6. The court will not deal with matters that were not placed timeously. If your matter was properly enrolled but does not appear on the roll, please contact or approach the enrollment office.
7. The Judge may communicate with the parties' representatives via widely shared notes posted on the electronic file. Legal representatives are to look out for these communications and are requested to respond to such communications.
8. Parties whose matters are on court online are to ensure that the Judge has access to the Caselines bundle by no later than **Friday, 10 July 2026 at 16h00**, failing which the matter may be removed from the roll

UNOPPOSED DIVORCES

9. All unopposed divorces and unopposed applications will be heard on **Monday, 13 July 2026 at 10h00** during a physical court hearing.
10. In respect of the unopposed divorces, the following directive will apply:-

- 10.1 In **all** matters involving pension fund endorsements, the Court requires documentary proof that the relevant pension fund administrator has approved the wording contained in the settlement agreement and/or draft court order. This requirement is intended to ensure compliance and to avoid future applications for variation. Such documentary proof may include:-
- 10.1.1 a letter from the pension fund administrator, attached to an affidavit deposited to by the attorney of record; or
 - 10.1.2 an affidavit deposited to by the attorney of record confirming that verbal approval of the wording was obtained from the pension fund administrator.
- 10.2 Proof of service of a notice of set down must be accompanied by a service affidavit deposited to by the attorney of record. An email "read receipt" or "delivery receipt", without a supporting affidavit, does not constitute sufficient proof of service.
- 10.3 In matters where there are no minor children and the parties have concluded a written settlement agreement, the Court will receive evidence by way of affidavit, unless the presiding Judge directs otherwise by way of a note on Caselines.
- 10.4 In matters where there are no minor children and the parties have not concluded a written settlement agreement, the Court will receive evidence

by way of affidavit, unless the presiding Judge directs otherwise by way of a note on Caselines.

10.5 In **all** matters involving minor children, the Court will receive oral evidence.

10.6 In **all** matters where one or both parties are unrepresented, the Court will receive oral evidence.

URGENT APPLICATIONS

11. All urgent applications will have a roll call on **Tuesday, 14 July 2026** in open court at **10h00** and ALL parties in ALL matters are required to be present. The urgent applications roll will be published in due course.

RULE 43 AND ORDINARY OPPOSED APPLICATIONS

12. All opposed rule 43 and ordinary opposed applications are allocated to be heard in open court at a specified date and time. Counsel will only be required to attend court on the specifically allocated date and time.
