Judge's Directives:

All matters will be heard from 15 September 2026.

1. All matters will be heard in open court. Court will commence at 10h00, and matters shall be called in the order of seniority.
2. Counsel are excused from introducing themselves in chambers. Counsel may introduce themselves in Court.
3. If a matter becomes settled or is to be removed or postponed, the Judge's Registrar must be informed without delay.
4. Counsel need not come to court on Tuesday merely to stand a matter down to Wednesday as matters that are not called in court on Tuesday shall automatically stand down till the following day (Wednesday).

5. On Thursday all matters not mentioned shall be called out and struck off the roll if there is no appearance in court.
6. No matters shall be allowed to stand down to Friday 18 September 2026, unless such a matter is merely standing down for settlement only and/or a Draft Order.
7. An **updated** practice note and draft order must be uploaded to CaseLines by **16h00** on **Friday 11 September 2026**.

7.1. Practice note: the updated practice note must stipulate:

7.1.1. Where specifically on CaseLines the following are located (i) the application for default judgment; (ii) proof of service of the application and set down on the RAF; and (iii) the relevant expert reports including the expert confirmatory affidavits.

7.1.2. A summary of the submissions with reference to (i) the evidence to be adduced in support of the RAF's liability; and (ii) the calculation of the damages in the draft order, with specific reference to each category of damage(s), including inter alia:

7.1.2.1. the liability of the RAF with reference to the specific section of the RAF Act 1996 as may be applicable, in particular in relation to general damages and the serious injury assessment report contemplated in section 17(1) of the RAF Act;

7.1.2.2. if general damages are claimed – list the authorities / case law relied upon for the quantum, including a brief description of the injuries;

7.1.2.3. if damages for loss of income / income earning capacity are claimed – a summary of the submissions including the pre- and post-accident scenarios and contingencies deductions; and

7.1.2.4. if damages for past medical / hospital / related costs are claimed – a summary of the submissions (including proof of costs and reasonableness thereof, as well as if any interim payments have been made and if so, the details thereof).

7.2. Heads of Argument:

4.2.1 Counsel must upload heads of arguments on caseLines, preferably short heads, latest by 10H00am on Monday the 14th September 2026.

- 4.2.2 Updated/supplementary heads of arguments must be uploaded on caseLines in case of any further developments on the claim.
- 7.3. Draft order:
- 7.3.1. Counsel must bring a hard copy of the draft order to hand up in Court. The draft orders must be signature ready and contain (i) the details of Counsel (ii) the date of the hearing (iii) the number on the court roll and (iv) the Judge's particulars.
- 7.3.2. Draft orders must be uploaded onto CaseLines in PDF and Word format. The order to be handed up in Court must have the word "draft" removed from the tramlines and the words "further and/or alternative relief" removed from the prayers.
8. If a matter becomes settled in terms of a settlement agreement and the plaintiff's attorneys have concluded contingency fee agreements with the plaintiff, affidavits in compliance with section 4 of the Contingency Fees Act 1997 must be uploaded to Case Lines. Practitioners are reminded of the requirements referred to and summarised in paragraph 20 of *Mbethe v Road Accident Fund* [2023] ZAMPMBHC 5.
9. Any party who wishes to be a party or participate in the default judgment proceedings must give the other party a prior notice in terms of the Uniform Rules and/or the Practice Manual.
10. Litigation by ambush is not permitted (See *Minister of Land Affairs & Agriculture v D & F Wevell Trust* [2007] SCA 153(RSA) at paragraph 43 and *Doorware CC v Mercury Fittings CC* (Case No 836/2023) ZASCA 25 [2025] at paragraph at 16.)
